

Research in Communication: Training & Science Slam

The 3-day blended training program (online + onsite) focuses on developing science communication skills for a general audience. Participants will learn how to present their research in a clear, engaging, and impactful way.

The highlight of the training will be a publicly staged Science Slam. Researchers will have 6 minutes to explain their projects in a clear, creative, and entertaining way - no slides full of data, just good storytelling. The twist? The audience decides who wins. It's science made simple, surprising, and memorable!

Researchers from ALL disciplines and career stages are welcome!

Group registration and presentations are possible — a project can be pitched by two or more people.

For the final public event, a maximum of 8 pitches will be accepted.
